We are committed to providing a safe, positive, and respectful environment for all children attending our Martial Arts classes. This Behaviour Code outlines the expectations we have for students, parents, and staff to ensure that every session is enjoyable, productive, and conducted in a respectful atmosphere. Please read carefully and ensure both students and parents understand and agree to these guidelines.

For Students:

1. Respect for Others:

- Always show respect to instructors, fellow students, and staff.
- No bullying, teasing, or inappropriate language will be tolerated.
- Follow the instructions given by instructors without disruption or argument.

2. Safety First:

- Practice techniques safely, without roughness or intent to harm.
- Always listen to safety instructions before practicing techniques.
- Inform an instructor if you or anyone else is injured or feels unwell.

3. Focus & Participation:

- Pay attention during lessons and actively participate in all activities.
- Do your best in each class, working towards improvement.
- Arrive on time and be ready to start class with the correct attitude and mindset.

4. JiuJitsu Etiquette:

- Bow when entering and leaving the training area as a sign of respect.
- Wear your uniform (Gi) properly and keep it clean for each session.
- Treat training equipment with care and do not use it without permission.

5. Good Sportsmanship:

- Support your classmates and celebrate their achievements as well as your own.
- Be patient and kind, especially when working with less experienced students.
- Remember, JiuJitsu is about learning and self-improvement, not winning.

For Parents:

1. Respect for Instructors and Club Rules:

- Trust the instructor's professional judgement in class management and discipline.
- Please refrain from intervening or coaching your child during the session.

2. Punctuality:

- Ensure your child arrives on time for each session and is collected promptly after class.
- If your child is going to be late or miss a session, please notify us in advance.

3. Communication:

- Keep open lines of communication with instructors regarding any concerns about your child's behaviour, development, or wellbeing.
- Inform us of any relevant medical conditions or special needs your child may have.

4. Positive Encouragement:

- Encourage your child to listen to the instructor and follow the class structure.
- Praise your child's efforts and progress, focusing on improvement rather than just results.

5. Club Environment:

- Help maintain a positive and respectful atmosphere by adhering to our behaviour code.
- Any issues between students should be raised with the instructor rather than handled between parents.

Consequences for Misbehaviour:

We believe in positive reinforcement and aim to correct misbehaviour through teaching and encouragement. However, repeated or serious breaches of the behaviour code may result in:

1. A verbal warning from the instructor.
2. Temporary exclusion from certain activities.
3. A meeting with parents to discuss behaviour.
4. Temporary or permanent suspension from the club in cases of persistent misbehaviour or serious incidents.
